Archbishop Shane Parker is the **15th Primate of the Anglican Church of Canada**, having been elected by General Synod in June 2025. As Primate, he serves as the senior pastoral leader of the Anglican Church of Canada, supporting the Church's mission and ministry across the entire country and representing Canadian Anglicans nationally and internationally.

Born in Edmonton and raised in western Canada, Archbishop Shane studied sociology at Carleton University before pursuing theological studies at Saint Paul University. He was ordained a priest in the Diocese of Ottawa in 1987 and served the Diocese in a variety of ministries, including as Archdeacon, Dean of Ottawa and Rector of Christ Church Cathedral for twenty years. He was elected Bishop of Ottawa in 2020 and served in that role until becoming Primate.

Throughout his ministry, Archbishop Shane has had a particular commitment to **reconciliation, interfaith dialogue and building relationships across communities**. He is the author of *Answering the Big Questions*, a collection of pastoral essays, and is a recipient of the Interfaith Ottawa Award.

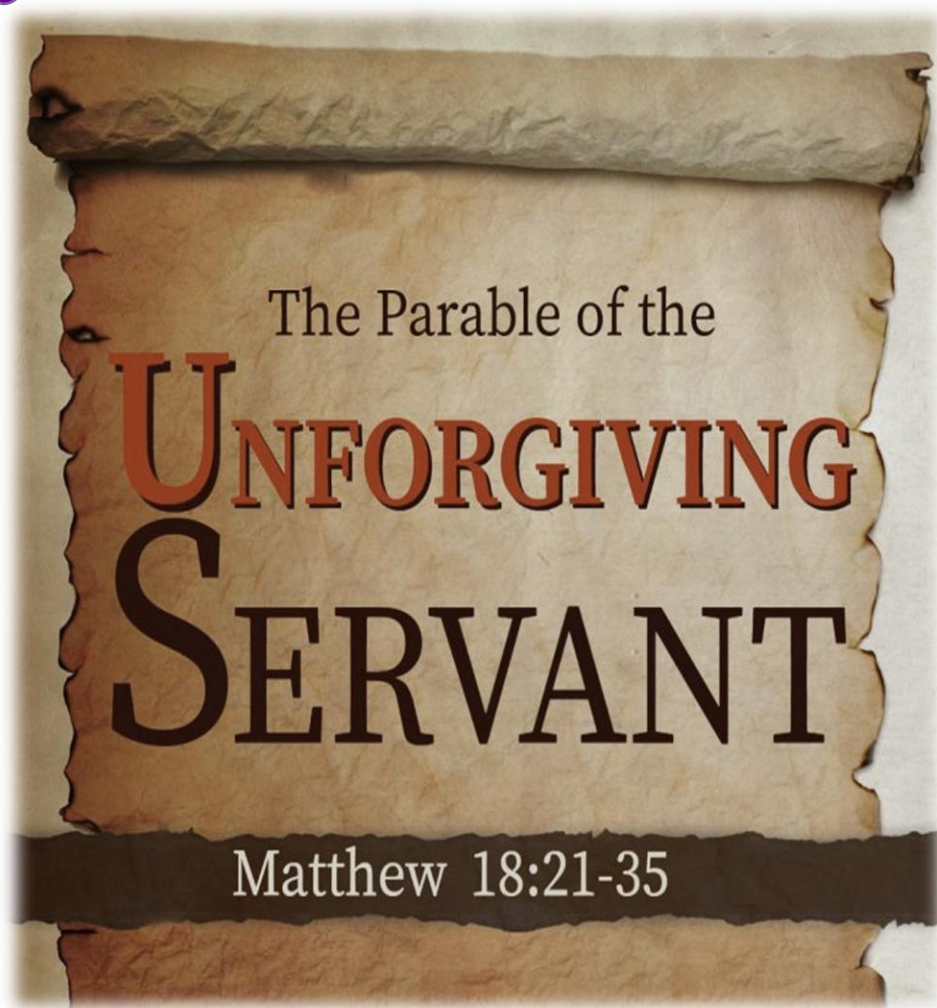
