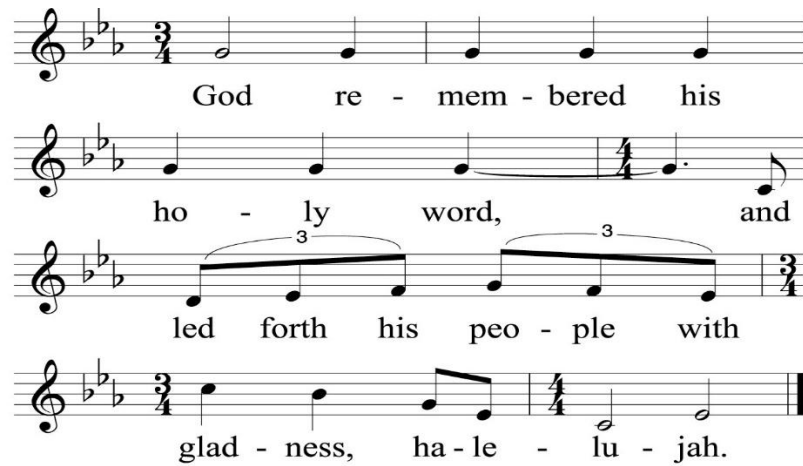


Psalm 105:1-6, 37-45
