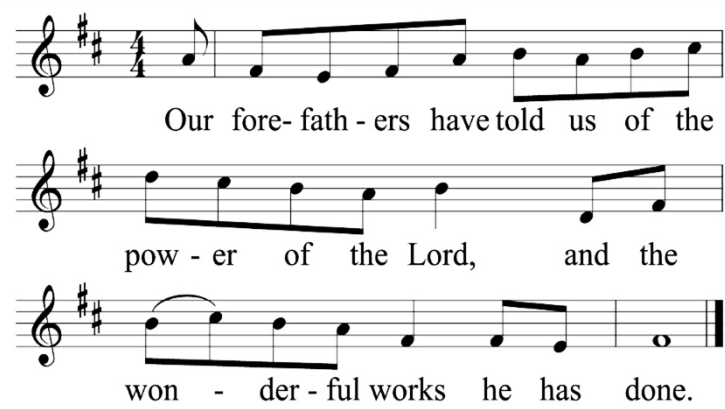


Psalm 78:1-4, 12-16

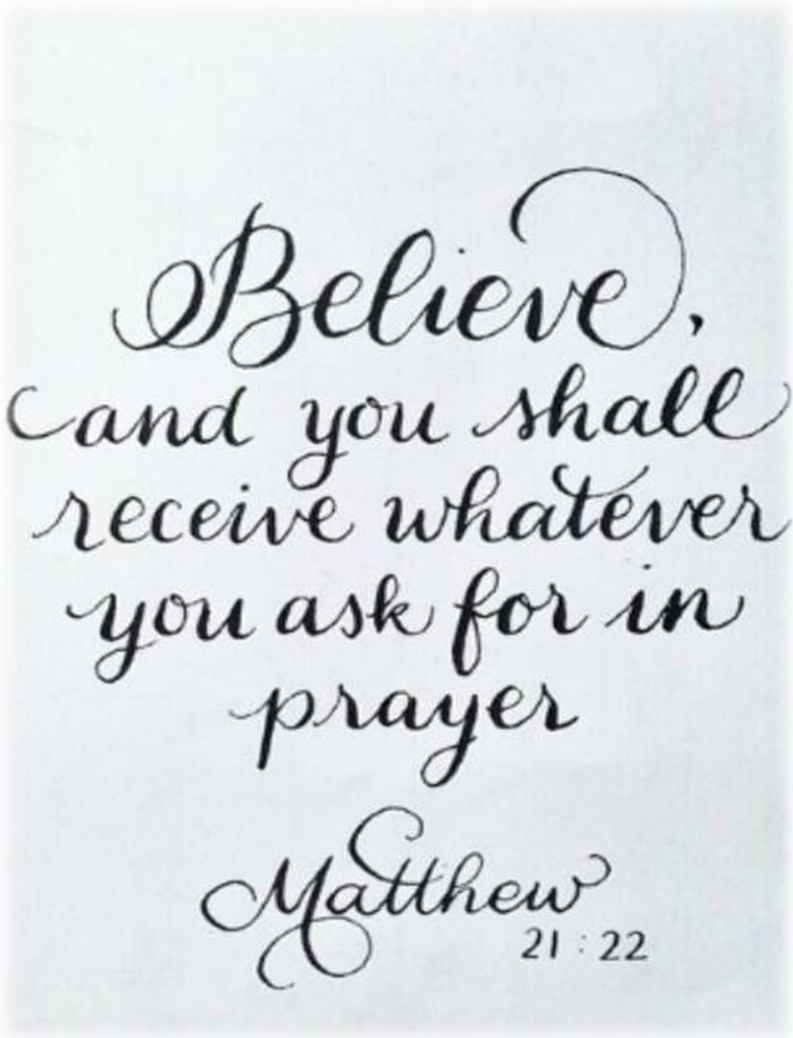
