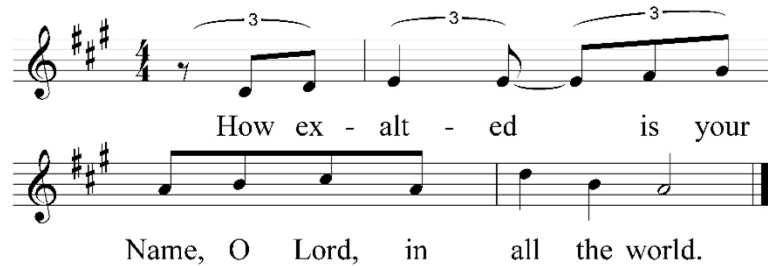


## Psalm 8
